## **Outsmarting Internet Explorer 7: Get Your Commissions!**

Hello, and thanks for purchasing **Outsmarting Internet Explorer 7: Get Your Commissions!**

Since you've purchased this guide, I assume you know “the big problem”. Since Internet Explorer 7 has a default feature that blocks cookies, and nearly every affiliate program out there uses cookies to determine who gets credit for a purchase, many people are losing nearly all of their commissions. A huge percentage of our customers are using Internet Explorer 7.

Needless to say, this is a huge blow to affiliate marketing. There are very few (if any) affiliate programs out there that don't use cookies.

What's worse is that there's no “secret workaround” to this problem. You can't put a snippet of code on your website or in your links to ensure you get credit 100% of the time. You have to get creative when these sort of problems arise.

This quick guide is meant to show you a couple of techniques that will drastically increase your chances of getting your well deserved commission. They're nothing revolutionary, but hopefully you'll get an idea or two about how to conquer this problem, and maybe come up with some of your own.

By the way, you have **Master Resale Rights** to this report. That means you can sell it and sell the resale rights to others at any price.

Let's get started...

# Technique #1

## Reward your visitors for using your affiliate link.

This is probably the most effective technique you'll see here. Unfortunately, it requires a bit of work on your part.

All you need to do is to write a short, supplemental report on an affiliate product you're selling. It doesn't need to be long, but you should (obviously!) do a little research to provide something valuable. The [Simple Content Generation System](#) will reveal a technique I use to drastically cut down the amount of time it takes to generate a "free report" of this sort. Tell people that when they buy through your affiliate link, you'll e-mail them your bonus report.

This will make your visitors **want** to use your affiliate link, and they'll actively look to make sure that you'll be getting credit for the sale. To do this, simply tell them how to check to make sure that they'll be purchasing through your affiliate link.

I highly suggest showing a screenshot to show them where to look for your affiliate link, if possible. A picture speaks a thousand words. Take a look:

So, to summarize, you're basically making your potential customer do the work FOR you. You're "pre-selling" them by offering a bonus report by buying through your link, and ensuring that your visitor double checks to make sure that you're getting credit. Simple, and effective!

# Technique #2

## Use PHP Redirects

Instead of using redirects with HTML, set up a PHP redirect. I'm a marketer, not a programmer, so I couldn't tell you why this works, but I've done a little research and have discovered that when using a PHP redirect, the chances of your affiliate cookie "getting through" to Internet Explorer 7 dramatically increases. Here's how to setup a PHP redirect page...

Step 1: Create a new file using notepad.

Step 2: Enter the following lines into Notepad:

```
<?php  
header("Location:http://www.youraffiliatelink.com");  
?>
```

Step 3: Go to "File," and choose "Save As"

Step 4: Enter the name of the file, and put .php at the end. For example, if I was promoting "\$7 Secrets," the file name could be 7secrets.php.

Step 5: Upload to your server and test it. It should redirect you automatically to your affiliate link with no fuss or delay.
